WE ARE ALSO GRATEFUL THAT ONLY A MATTER OF WEEKS AGO WE SHARED A VERY HAPPY TIME TOGETHER IN WINNIPEG WHEN JANICE WAS HONOURED BY B'NAI BRITH.

YOU FEELING? HOW ARE THE KIDS?" EVEN IN NOVEMBER HE WAS TELLING ME ABOUT HIS "CUSTOMERS" AS HE CALLED THEM. IT'S NO SURPRISE TO ANYONE WHO KNEW HIM THAT HE WENT INTO WORK EVERY DAY – EARLY! – TILL THE DAY HE DIED. TO MAURICE IT WASN'T WORK. IT WAS WHAT HE ENJOYED DOING. I KNOW THERE ARE MANY HERE TODAY, WHO MET MAURICE THROUGH WORK AND WERE HIS CLIENTS. I KNOW THAT HE STILL HAS FRIENDS WHO HE DID BUSINESS WITH IN WINNIPEG WHEN HE WAS IN THE SCHMATTA BUSINESS WHO STILL RECALL HIM FONDLY.

MAURICE WASN'T AVERAGE IN ANY WAY. HE ALWAYS HAD TO HAVE A BIG CAR. WITH HIS SIZE, HE COULDN'T GET COMFORTABLE IN A SMALLER ONE.
