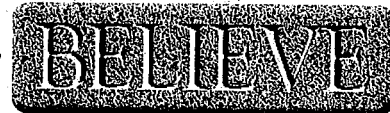
Bob was a provincial court judge for over 33 years and sat in most courts throughout Alberta. He had a distinguished career in which he was well respected.
