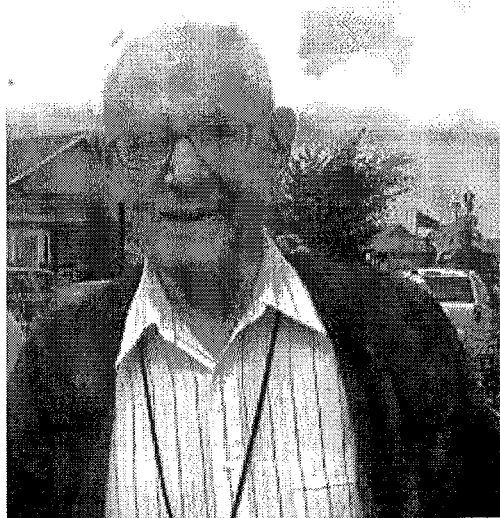

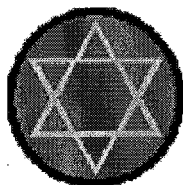

It is with great sadness that

 the age of 94 years, at
 the Edmonton General
 Continuing Care Centre. Leon

grew up in Winnipeg MB and Mundare, AB.
 He married Rebecca Frohlich on August 18,
 1940 and together they raised four daughters.
 Leon pursued a variety of business interests in
 Edmonton, mainly working in retail, and serving
 as a consultant with the Federal Business
 Development Bank. He also spent 16 years in
